UACNJ Tent

One of the items discussed at the October, 3 meeting was the purchase of a tent to be used by member clubs for special events. Instead of renting a tent at high rental costs, particularly for smaller clubs, the tent would be loaned to member clubs for their event, defraying rental costs, and making available often needed space for such things as swap tables, talks, etc. and making fund raising events more profitable. The UACNJ is requesting that each club make available \$40 toward the payment of such a tent.

UACNJ Messier Certificates

Prepared by the Hopatcong Area Amateur Astronomers, Hopatcong, NJ, the UACNJ will offer special recognition to individuals in the form of Messier Object Certificates. There are at least two purposes in awarding such a certificate: to encourage beginning astronomers to systematically observe the sky (the Messier objects are a good starting point and have all varieties of deep sky objects; galaxies, open and globular clusters, planetary nebulae, etc.), and to allow club members who are not members of the Astronomical League to receive recognition for locating all of the Messier objects.
