There were displays by amateurs and clubs from around the state. Several telescopes and the spectra scope were on display. There was solar observing during the afternoon, and a swap table and flea market. Radio astronomy was represented by a satellite downlink which received NASA select live coverage of the Space Shuttle Mission. In the evening there was good viewing despite a bright moon. To top off a great day, for those who stayed up until 1 AM, was a fine aurora display.
